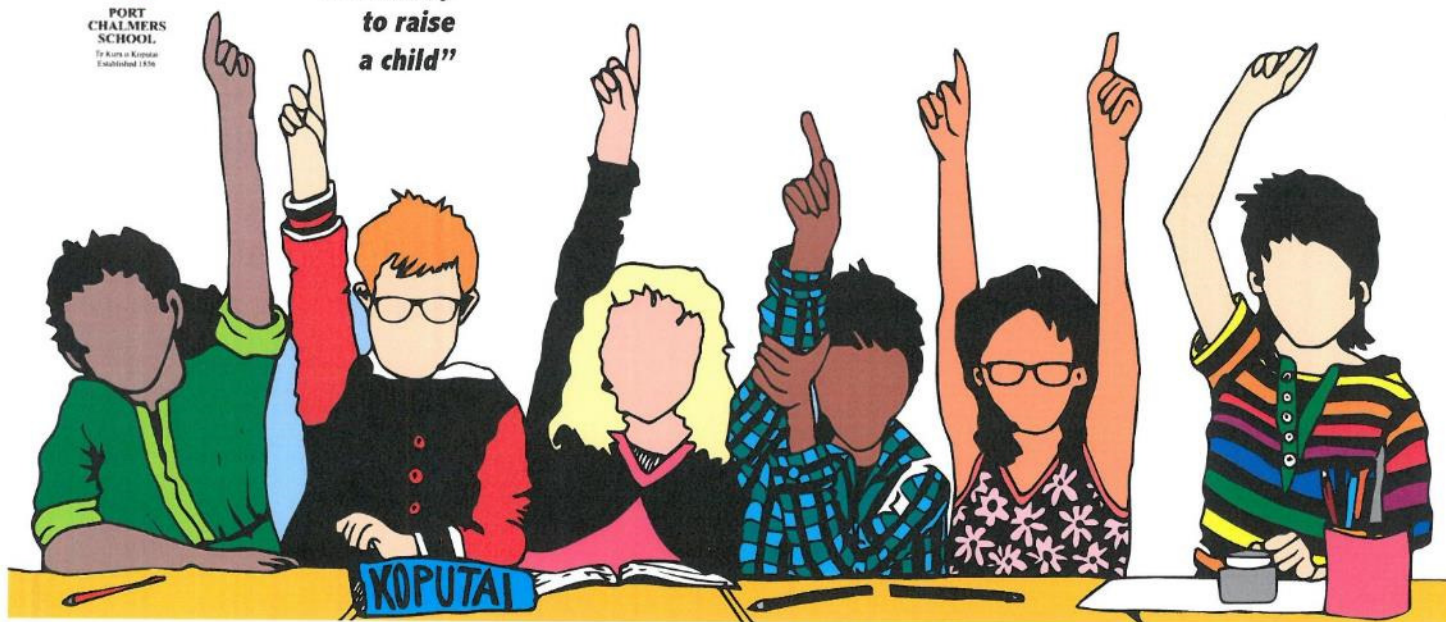

INFLUENZA VACCINE & ELIGIBILITY

The Ministry of Health is encouraging as many people as possible to be vaccinated against seasonal influenza. This year the pandemic strain (H1N1 or also known as Swine Flu) is included in the seasonal influenza vaccination. It is free for all those who:

- are pregnant
- are significantly overweight
- use asthma preventers
- have diabetes
- are aged 65 years or over
- have heart disease
- have kidney problems
- or have a serious medical condition

If you do not have one of these eligible conditions you can still benefit from an influenza immunization available at a small cost and is provided by your family doctor.

Orders will need to be in at the Office before school in a named envelope with room number and choice, and correct change. We will order the lunches which will then be picked up and given out at 12:30pm.

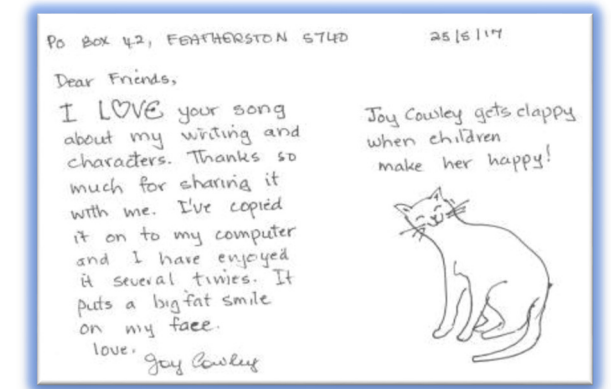
