Come along and sew an awesome badge with help from Alison – sewer extraordinaire! Friday 13th 1 – 3pm Children must be able to thread a needle

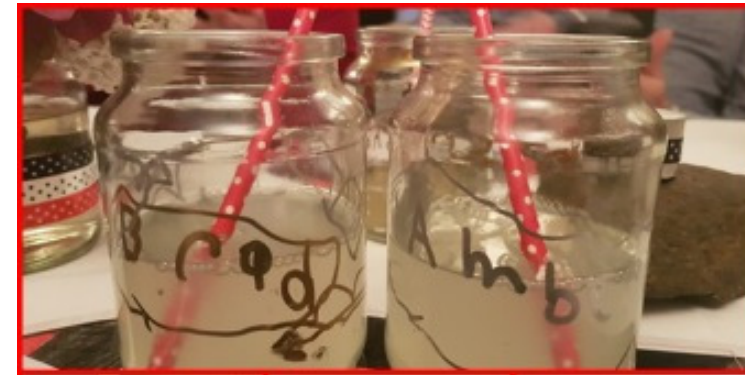
Sediment and Seashore
