This week we made apple and Pumpkin muffins, We had fun improvising as I was running late that morning and didn't have time to do a shop.

The apples were from my trees and the rest of the ingredients are what we had in the school pantry, so we had fun using what we had, and the muffins were "really good"!

Here's the recipe Enjoy! Hagar.

### Spicy Apple and Pumpkin Muffins

Makes 12 muffins

- 3 cups flour
- 1 Tablespoon baking powder
- ¼ teaspoon baking soda
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ½ tsp cinnamon
- ½ tsp ground nutmeg
- ½ tsp mixed spice
- ¾ cup firmly packed soft brown sugar
- 2 free range eggs
- 1 cup coconut milk
- ½ cup oil (grape seed, safflower or olive oil are best)
- ½ tsp vanilla extract
- 1 cup of cooked apple pieces
- ½ cooked pumpkin pieces

Preheat oven to 210\*c

Cook apples and pumpkin and set aside

Mix all dry ingredients in a large bowl.

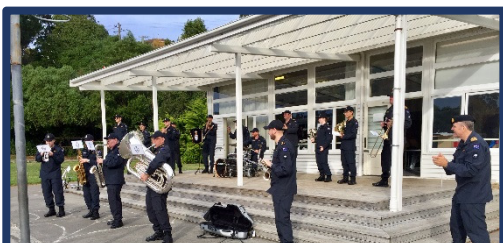
Mix wet and add into the dry ingredients, add the

apple and pumpkin. Mix until combined, don't over-mix.

Spoon into greased muffin tray, bake for 20 min in 210\*c or until golden brown.
