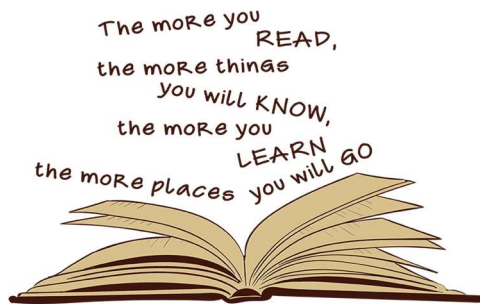
Book Week

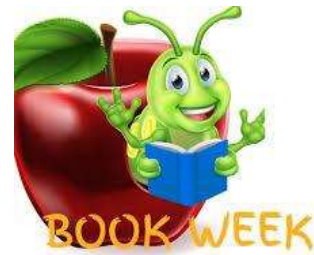

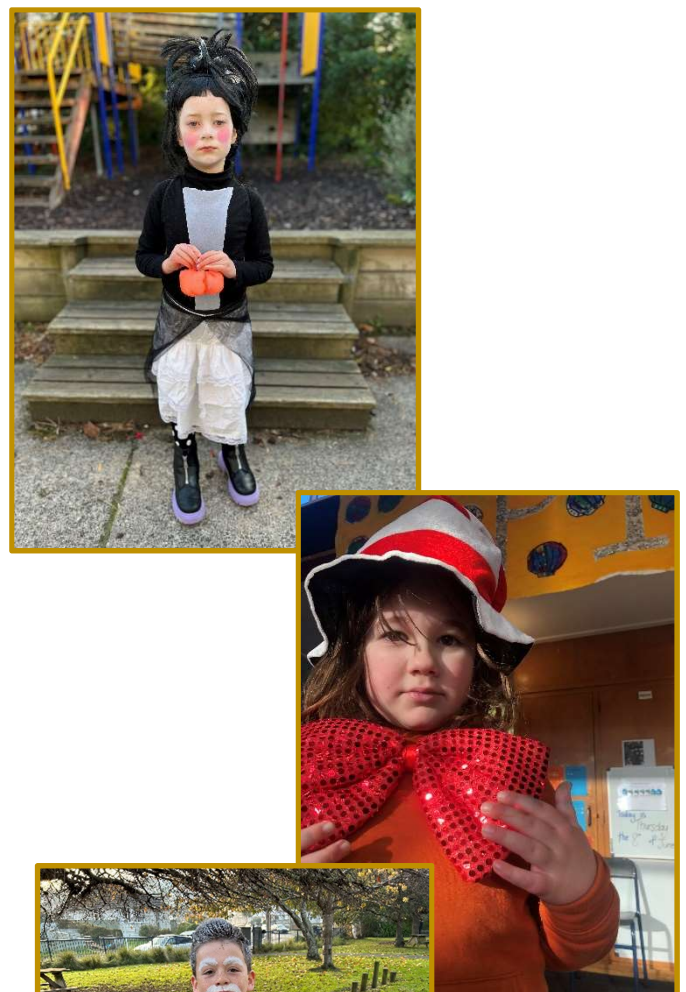
